## **PUBLIC MEMBER POLICY:**

After giving consideration to the needs of each Standing Committee ("committee") and to the importance of developing balanced and diverse representation, members of the public ("Public Members") may be appointed/reappointed to any committee, except the Executive Committee, by the Board Chairperson with consultation with the respective committee Chairperson. The number of Public Members on any given committee shall not exceed the number of Board Members on the committee. Voting privileges of appointed Public members are limited to business before their appointed committee. Each Public Member shall be appointed and may be reappointed for terms of one year beginning September 1<sup>st</sup> and shall be held to the same standards of conduct applicable to Community Board Members.

In order to be appointed/reappointed as a Public Member of a committee, an individual must submit a written application to the Board Chairperson using the application form that is available (on the reverse side of this policy). An individual may apply and be appointed as a Public Member of a committee only after having attended at least two-thirds of all meetings of the committee over the six-month period that the committee has met immediately preceding the individual's application. Public Members who are absent more than two (2) committee meetings in any one term shall be reviewed for removal from the respective committee.

Public Members serve at the pleasure of the Board Chairperson and as such may be removed at the sole discretion of the Chairperson without due process after consultation with the appropriate committee Chairperson.
