

Metropolitan Museum of Art — Upper East Side

Ages: Completing 10th to 12th grade and recent graduates residing in New York, New Jersey or Connecticut

Application due: Saturday, April 1, 2017

This internship consists of three main components: A department placement chosen based on the student's interests, rotation through an assortment of career labs, and gallery sessions where pairs of interns lead discussions about a particular work of art.

New York County District Attorney's High School Internship Program — Citywide

Ages: 10th to 12th graders

Application due: Saturday, April 8, 2017

Interns help out in one of three different District Attorney's offices, as well as attend special presentations and field trips, and take part in mock trial competitions. Interns receive a weekly stipend of \$150.

ArtsLife at the Museum of Art & Design — Midtown West

Ages: Current sophomores and juniors

Application due: Sunday, April 30, 2017

For seven weeks, teens learn about museum career options like curating art, art education, development, public relations and marketing, visitor services and security. Field trips and leadership workshops are included. Paid; \$9/hour.

Central Park Conservancy — Parkwide

Ages: Must be 16 by June 1

Application due: Sunday, April 30, 2017

Interns work five days a week and some weekends on individual projects, then come together as a group on Fridays for field trips, or a group activity of in-depth study in the fields of horticulture or public programming. Paid internship; rates TBD
