Ms. Deirdre Parker and Mr. Gary Smalls of MTA NYC Transit came before the committee with regards to making 133rd Street between Broadway and 12th Avenue making it one way going west for the duration of the work. This will take approximately 6 months. The MTA has met with the KIPP Charter Schools at 625 West 133rd Street across from the site and for the safety of the children is why the MTA is requesting the street to be made one way.

After discussion with the committee, safety of the children comes first, therefore the committee has no objections to the street change.

DOT – Lyle Blackwood and Jesse Minte-Roth on the discussions of the proposed loading zones.

Dot presented the committee with 12 loading zones locations, and all 12 will not be picked.

No bus stops will be removed and the committee will have a further discussion on the loading zones at the May meeting and the ones that the committee feels will best serve the community.

It was also discussed the 116th St and Riverside Drive of which that project was never finished, and DOT promised Angle Parking would be done at 120th Street which also was never done.
