A young women 26 from Grant Houses committed suicide leaving behind 2 young children.

<u>DOT – Lyle Blackwood</u> Spoke on the Harlem Bike Network whereas CB11 has approved the Bike Lanes, as well as CB10, CB7 has requested protected bike lanes.
