- Submission date 3/15/19
- Selection of a lead organization through the Upper Manhattan Collaborative for Justice
 - o Consideration WHDC / Harlem Community Justice Center
- Potential partnering organizations:
 - o Talon Murphy Foundation
 - o Fortune Society
 - o Harlem Defenders
 - o Columbia University
- Funding: \$ 3 million over 3 ½ to lead organization
 - \$ 20 thousand in micro -grants to partner organizations
