- A Michael Palma-West Harlem Arts Alliance (WHAA)-
 - WHAA promotes arts and arts organizations in Harlem and leverage the
 cultural assets of the community to bring more attention to our creative
 sector and creative economy. WHAA intends to have an arts organization
 and artist directory as well.
 - WHAA is looking for a home and requested support a submit a resolution for Columbia University who is our partner in the community to provide access to 5,000 square feet of dedicated space within the development area (Manhatanville). Further access to other spaces should be available as well as per the Community Benefits Agreement (CBA). The space can be used by organizations, the arts community and also residents intersecting there.

- WHAA can be the liaison between the community and Columbia for other spaces at Columbia as well.
- WHAA has contacted Columbia and Columbia promises to continue to search for space, however, in 6 months, nothing has happened
- Columbia now has a new president and WHAA believes this resolution is the reaffirmation of our partnership with Columbia
- WHAA wants a resolution in lieu of a letter of support for the requested space because, per WHAA, community resolution speaks from 180,000 community residents, and not just the 50 board members
- Hon. Daria Hardeman requested an amendment that the requested 5000 square feet not be used just for one organization.
- Hon. Victor Edwards noted that it has been difficult obtaining space from Columbia and we pay for MCB(office space.
- CBA promised 5000 square feet space and WHAA wants Columbia to deliver on that promise

 - Karl is a community member and provides an annual block party and wants to expand into art projects for the community. His idea is a music and art festival for the community where we can utilize the great outdoor space and talent. This can be an opportunity to show different cultures as well.,
