Monique introduced herself and asked others to do the same

Updates from the summer/Office of Cannabis Management (OCM)

Monique shared the following:

- The task force's successful activities to engage the community and increase awareness (see attached notes)
- Alerted the members that there would be an expansion to approve more retail licenses October
 With this pending event, she stressed the need for our CB to establish regulations and guidelines to help control the flow of new legal dispensaries in our community.
- Attended the Uniform Services & Transportation to initiate the discussion and followed up with Carolyn Thompson to review and discuss the DRAFTED Regulation and Guidelines. Edits were made (see attachment) with the understanding that we need to follow up on some items with someone from OCM or the Cannabis Control Board. Members expressed concern about the presence of illegal dispensaries in the community. We will find out who the local enforcement in our community is and invite them to join us at future meetings to answer questions and address these concerns.
- Attended the Economic Development and West Harlem Piers Committee Meeting and engaged in a brief conversation with the Chairs about the Marine Transfer Station. The goal is to work with a member of their committee to solicit feedback to finalize the DRAFT LOS and to move forward the development of the valuable space on the Hudson River.

Discussion: Community event or a workshop

Monique asked members to think about our taskforce's next steps/activity in the community to:

- Increase visibility and awareness about the legal opportunities associated with the cannabis industry
- o Breaking the stigma: re-educate seniors, youth/parents

<u>Comment:</u> the way we proceed will depend on the group we want to target, which will dictate the approach we will use.
