- · CBC determines age group
- · more people vaccinates better for community
- · explanation of process approval & vaccine safety monitoring, MNRA tech
- · Pfizer is 95% effective 16 and over
- · Moderna 95% 18 and over
- · unknown: how long it will last, if we need a booster
- no children under 16
- · does being vaccinated spread: do not know

- middle of 2021 widespread distribution working with all city agencies working together to ensure quick safe distribution
- will be free to all regardless of immigration status.
- · everyone will get a card which says date of 1st vaccination, provider will also contact
- No answer if you miss your 2nd dose schedule: will get back to us
- · Bell's Palsy concern raised
- · Have a conversation to your health care provider prior to taking.

3. New Window at 3333 Broadway: pet safety concerns

presenter: Lana Orins - a law building liable to keep human safe, why be pet friendly & not keep pet safe

- Background, new windows installed they swing out, tenants have to pay for additional window guards and screen installation. 6 pet deaths 1 dog, 5 cats

little animal rights in NYC: animals in buildings "high rise cat syndrome", its known

- kids can fall out of these windows
- building going for sale next year,
- Victor reached out to landlord: everything is legal per code
- HPD says they can open to 4"

also city code do not have to supply screens and window guards, by Law builder not responsible

Victor told by residents want to wait for different tenant association in new Year when he offered to meet with them December 2020, Victor has spoken to HPD, MBP & tenants want to wait

No Covid testing proof to tenants on workers

ACTION ITEM: This is a hyper local issue, The height + location could be causing wind gusts, additional safety concerns. The windows appear to be to code. Residents, concerned citizens, CB9 can work together to change the laws in NYC that currently do not protect pets very well in pet friendly buildings. Meantime Pet owners need to protect pets, keep windows locked.

Residents can & should refuse windows if they have a concern

Education/information needs to happen, people are excited for new windows but not aware of issues/concerns Confirm are laws applied to vertical or horizontal space

Rent stabilized tenants DOH website has information on requirements for windowguards. follow it
