Mr. Sinai St. Luke's Nurses: (Jeremy Markman, Director of Strategic Campaigns and Special Projects New York State Nurses Association, was not present)

concerns with Mt sinai morning side nurse complaints with hours, staffing Madeline 20 years ER nurse: need help frontline, a lot of health physic social needs

- short staffed what it means for us
- 100 patients cannot turn anyone away, ED techs, no cap carrying up to 20 patients with no ED techs can have a trauma and ICU strokes, seizures- workload unmanageable, nurses leaving replaced with new grads hard to tain people when you have such a big load. triage nurse, er nurse

- nurses are burnt out jeopardize their license, decide which person who they can provided care for. behavior and physic patients are taking more nurses
- loved ones sit in urine/feces, may develop pressure ulcer, or die, spike in admissions for ED, 40 impatience normal(in an out patients) will stay for days no additional staff all handled by ER nurses
- at times no ED techs cannot get vitals
- all patients pediatric, cardiac COvid, shuffling deck who gets treated first pushed to limit
- being told to have meetings need more staff, more retention, boost morale
- up too 100 patients in ED everyday
- ICU patients staffing on those units very bad 34-48 hours when they should be impatient

- MT sinai West: labor and delivery, mini hospital within hospital, cannot turn patients away, should be staff 17 nurses day/night— now 8 days struggle to have 10. Many labor delivery need 1-1 care. managing sick women in labor when you do not have enough nurses, to do safe delivery in OR have to pull nurses
- has to do with the fact that nurses get trained for 4 months, come off orientation and leave after 1 month. work many days 12+ hour shift no breaks
- people are mentally and physically sick Morale is very low
- Do not know what to do to get more nurses
- problems with payrollMt sinai West: issues with disability, maternity leave, PTO time goes missing

- long beurocratic process, nurses feel punished and being pushed out
- Q: is this problem the whole system or just Mt Sinai St lukes thier issuing a different email for Met life separating MT sinai west
- turnaround— staffing issues
- staff not orientating new nurses nurses being denies personal time EPD, not able to use all vacation
- Q: what is union's position?
- contractional process, go through labor management meetings, next unit issues have unit based meetings (about 5 labor management and ED meetings, going nowhere: getting same response COVID, using it as a freeze hire make due with what we have- no support, even getting a mediator most mediation is staffing
- ED short staffed 20-24 working with 1/2 daily- union advocating with them.
- our NYCHA during Covid had most deaths could be a connection
- willing to pay travelers more no incentive to stay

I heard of this and could not confirm yet...

Mount Sinai East(Main) is able to get OT incentive for staff RN's to come in .. but at the same time MSM and MSW can't seem to get management to agree to invest in giving OT incentives to encourage staff to come in
