A community resident complained about a Site Seeing bus left idling at 110th street and Commander Cascillo stated that he will reach out to NYPD traffic to issue summons to these bus drivers.

Michael Steigman of the Farmers Market came before the committee to complain about the cars parking at the location of the Farmers Market which creates a problem for the trucks to park. Det. Harper suggested that signs could be put up that would read YOUR CARS WILL BE TOWED if you park there.

Ted Kovaleff wanted to know about the rush hour traffic along Riverside Drive South Bound where a lane was removed. Mr. Kovaleff would like to have DOT reassess the traffic and let the committee know there finding. Reassessment should be on Broadway as well.

There were also concerns about empty Citi Bike stalls that can be removed, keep in mind that more that more stations are to be put into the community.
