What is happening with the scooter, Ebkes, where these people are riding on the sidewalks and how do we stop this. Motor cycles must have the proper license in order to ride.

There have been 8 crimes. Grant 6-7 Manhattanville 2-1 they are up 100% - Manhattanville 1 Felony Assault 1 Grand Larceny 5.1% 37-39 Grant Houses 41-43 Manhattanvill 16-16 – domestic Robbery of \$240.00, NYCHA Robberies of a electric drill, 2 Felonies both domestic, Burglary domestic. Be aware of people riding electric scooter and snatching phones. There have been a uptick in shooting.

Scams are still going if you do not know the number do not answer.

DOT Lyle Blackwood: DOT sent a letter to Community Board 9 in reference to 138th street Broadway to make the street 1 way Wes bound and will add additional parking on the Northern section.

DOT is requesting a letter of support from the committee, the committee is in support of a letter.

The work should be completed either in August or on the Fall.

Hon. Patricia Watler-Johnson stated that she notice a median at 135th street Broadway has been recently installed and Lyle stated that it had been due to the recent accidents in that area.

DOT will begin to install curb extensions at 113*115.

Hon. Victor Edwards stated that the White Lines have not been replaced on the 135th Via Duct.

Hon. Victor Edwards is still waiting for a will walk thru of Convent Avenue for additional parking.
