The money ran out so worked to get a grant so more food/meals could be provided for seniors.

Tuesday & every other Wednesday and Friday - fresh food is provided to seniors. This food is fresh from the farm (cucumbers, spinach, tomatoes, carrots, potatoes) as well as dry foods, toilet paper, dish washing liquid, soap. Roughly 5 bags per senior.

If a senior is not able to pick up the packages will be delivered.

Anyone can drop off absentee ballots at any polling site as long as it is signed MW Postmarking issue. This continues to be a problem – no postmark to prove ballot was sent before NOV. 3. Albany passed law that ballot can be considered if arrives on Nov. 4.

Okay for groups to gather ballots and drop them off at early voting/election day polling site. Proceed with caution to avoid accusations of ballot harvesting

W. Hamer - our organization could collect 100 ballots from seniors and hand deliver them.

Irene Zola - Bulletin for distribution with info for seniors. Outreach idea. Part of larger outreach effort.

Gail – Take issue with virtual doctor idea. Had pneumonia. How can a pulmonary issue be addressed virtually? Insist on first appointment, which seems like an excuse to charge extra.

M.W. Can only be part of first step. Must include a follow up appointment at hospital or with home visit.

Irene Zola – Follow up visits can work, depending on issue. Can reduce risk of exposure if there is only a need to ask questions. Could be a racket but could be preventative medicine.

WH – Yes, we've been thrust into virtual world – there is still a need for advocacy, for older people, wrap around service. Need to keep advocating and raising these issues. Asking questions. Should CB step in? There will be abuses and we must remain vigilant.

MW – VA, does DFTA do oversight on these issues? VA – not sure. Will inquire at Long Term Care Dept. They probably keep tabs on this. Concerned about someone staying in hosp. for 6 days. Need buddy system. Checking in on each other. 347-277-6929 – Verna Arthur.
