• 197a Housing Goals

- Maintain/protect current affordable housing and increase "affordable" unit within newly constructed developments:
 - Expand the current historic
 - Reexamine area zoning (up zoning, zoning against big box stores)
 - Closely monitor the NYCHA conversion to private management companies
 - Increase awareness of free Housing Legal advice through Palante Harlem and Manhattan Legal Services
 - Negotiate "Give Backs" to the community from Developers, i.e. Construction Agrees

• 197a Community Business Goals

- Support local small businesses
 - Connect businesses with Columbia's small business programs
 - Zoning against large box stores
 - Utilize Columbia's MBA students for mentoring as described in the CBA

• Educational Goals

- Monitor district school's performance and graduation rates
- Advocate for Skilled Trade programming within area schools
- o Promote availably of Tech Jobs curriculum within CUNY
